CREATIVE 360 RECEIVES MIDLAND AREA COMMUNITY FOUNDATION GRANT

June 29, 2015, Midland, Mich. – The Midland Area Community Foundation’s Board of Trustees recently awarded a \$10,000 grant to Creative 360 from its Unrestricted Endowment Fund. The grant is in support of a wellness pathway planned for the nonprofit’s outdoor space.

The fully accessible pathway, designed by Scott Lasky of Laskape Design & Landscape, will curve through Creative 360’s property at 1517 Bayliss St. Community created mosaic art will grace benches, sculptures and stepping stones for walkers to enjoy and rest upon. People of all ages and abilities will be able to regularly use the pathway to improve their fitness and well-being. It is slated for completion in late 2015.
